

	Basic communication proficiency skills acquired during introductory courses. This includes competency with grammar, writing, speaking and listening/comprehension.

Your essay should be focused, on-topic, and tailored to the Radiation Therapy discipline. be free from spelling and grammatical errors. clearly communicate why you should be selected for the Radiation Therapy program. be well-written and concise. be less than 500 words. Complete all sections of the online form: https://apply.uth.tmc.edu/psp/applyuth/APPLYUTH/ENTP/h/?tab=UT_EP_NVT_APPLYUTH Proofread your application form and electronically sign it. Note the account access information provided with confirmation from the Office of the Registrar.
C. PROFESSI	ONAL RECOMMENDATIONS – Must be <i>RECEIVED</i> by March 1
Date of completion	Description of Requirement
	1. Identify three (3) professional references Identify three individuals that can provide an appropriate professional recommendation. Examples of suitable individuals include instructors, professors, employers, and supervisors. Do not submit personal references such as family, friends, and clergymen.
	2. Download the recommendation form (<u>http://bit.ly/SHP-Rec-Form</u>) and distribute to your references.
	Recommendations must be written on the official form. Letters, emails, etc. will not be considered.
	3. Verify that Recommendation #1 has been received by the registrar's office. (check online account using procedure provided by registrar's office)





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2. Complete all supporting forms

- A. *All applicants* must complete
 - Clinical Site Visitor Profile (you must have an active application on file to schedule a visit)
- B. Applicants scheduling their clinical site visit at MD Anderson should complete
 ✓ Confidentiality form
- C. *Applicants scheduling their clinical site visit at a location other than MD Anderson* should provide the following forms to the licensed radiation therapist on site and ask them to complete
 - ✓ Clinical Site Visit form
 - ✓ Clinical Site Visit Evaluation form
- Send Site Visitor Profile, Site Visit Request, and Clinical Site Visit Evaluation forms to request a site visit at MD Anderson to

4. Attend both days of your clinical site visit prior to the March 1 deadline

- A. Two consecutive 8-hour days, for a total of 16 hours
- B. Conservative business casual clothing required (no jeans, t-shirts, shorts, or tank tops)
- C. Closed-toe shoes required (no sandals or flip-flops)
- D. Must have and wear a white lab coat.

The most competitive applicants will be invited to continue the admissions process by participating in an entrance examination, 16pf Core Personality Insight Assessment and personal interview with the Admission Committee.

Applicants are ranked based on:

- Clinical Site Visit Evaluation
- Completion of recommended courses
- Educational history (degree earned)
- Essay
- Interview
- Overall grade-point-average
- Performance on entrance examinations
- Prerequisite grade-point-average
- Professional recommendations

Individuals that do not receive an invitation to continue with the admissions process are encouraged to address any deficiencies in their applications and reapply to the Radiation Therapy program in the future.
