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Soothing Sounds

- [Purrli](#) – Cat sounds (browser; free)
- [Noisli](#) - Nature, fans, trains, white noise (browser or app; free or paid for versions)
- [Calm](#) – Soothing sounds and meditations; Bob Ross (browser or app; free and paid for versions)
- [Coffitivity](#) – Sounds of public spaces (free with a premium version available)
- Amazon Prime – Ad free nature sounds with a Prime account.
- Spotify – Soothing sounds with an account. Ad free if you pay.

WebEx Sharing Videos and Music

- Using the Share menu, you can share multimedia like YouTube videos to share sounds.
- Zoom is better at this! Use the “Share Computer Sounds” option.

- Go to “Edit”, “Preferences”, and turn off notifications.

WebEx Audio Troubleshooting

- Check your privacy settings; Confirm your device is enabled; Double check the levels and the mute button: <https://mdanderson.libguides.com/webex/audio>

WebEx Security for Hosts & Presenters

- **Block cameras** – Go to “Meeting”, “Options” and uncheck the box to “Allow all participants to turn on video”
- **Lock Meeting** – Go to “Meeting”, “Lock Meeting”. This will keep people from entering the meeting room once the meeting has started. They will be forced to wait in a “Lobby” instead.
- **WebEx Events & WebEx Trainings** allow the host to mute participants permanently. Participants will not be able to unmute themselves.
